Baptist Beliefs

From The New Hampshire Declaration Of Faith XII. Of the Harmony Of The Law And The Gospel

"We believe that the law of God is the eternal and unchangeable rule of his moral government; that it is holy, just, and good; and that the inability which the Scriptures ascribe to fallen men to fulfill its precepts, aspires entirely from their love of sin; to deliver them from which, and to restore them through a Mediator to unfeigned obedience to the holy law, is one great end of the gospel, and of the means of grace connected with the establishment of the visible church."

Romans 3:31 "Do we make void the law through faith? God forbid. Yea, we establish the law."

Romans 7:12 "The law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good."

Romans 8:7-8 "The carnal mind is enmity against God, for it is not subject to the law of God, neither in deed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God."

Romans 8:2-4 "For the law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son, in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh; that the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh but after the Spirit."

The law reveals our sin, the gospel reveals the One who forgives our sin. Jesus said He "came not to destroy the law but to fulfill it." Paul said the law was a "schoolmaster" or guide to Christ. The law was what bound the Hebrews together as a nation. The gospel binds the church together for the service to Christ. They are intertwined and should both be studied to understand the complete plan of God revealed to man.
