From the New Hampshire Declaration of Faith: XVIII Of The World To Come

We believe that the end of this world is approaching; that at the Last Day Christ will descend from heaven, and raise the dead from the grave to final retribution; that a solemn separation will then take place; that the wicked will be adjudged to endless punishment, and the righteous to endless joy; and that this judgment will fix forever the final state of men in heaven or hell, on principles of righteous.

I Peter 4:7 But the end of all things is at hand; be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.

Acts 1:11 The same Jesus which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.

Acts 24:15 There shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust.

Matthew 13:49 The angels shall come forth and sever the wicked from among the just.

Matthew 25:35-41 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into life everlasting. ect.
