Bible Trivia: (Answers to Last Week):

1. Jesus said to me, "...because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed..." Who am I? Thomas, John 20:29.
2. How many generations are from Abraham to Jesus? 42 Matthew 1:17.
3. Who was in the wilderness (desert) with Jesus when he was tempted forty days? Satan or devil, wild beasts, and angels, Mark 1:13.
4. What are the names of John the Baptist's Father and Mother? And, what was his father's office and responsibility? Zacharias and Elizabeth, The priest's office, and carried out the custom of burning incense when he went into the temple of the Lord. Luke 1: 5 – 9.
5. How many wives, princesses, and concubines did Solomon have before he died? Bonus: What did it do to his heart? And, how many can you name? I Kings 11:3, "And he had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart." "The first of Solomon's women noted in scripture is Pharaoh's daughter, and the Torah forbade the Israelites to intermingle with Egyptians. There are 30 books of the Bible in this paragraph. Can you find them? This is a most remarkable puzzle. It was found by a gentleman in an airplane seat pocket, on a flight from Los Angeles to Honolulu, keeping him occupied for hours. He enjoyed it so much, he passed it on to some friends. One friend from Illinois worked on this while fishing from his john boat. Another friend studied it while playing his banjo. Elaine Taylor, a columnist friend, was so intrigued by it she mentioned it in her weekly newspaper column. Another friend judges the job of solving this puzzle so involving, she brews a cup of tea to help her nerves. There will be some names that are really easy to spot. That's a fact. Some people, however, will soon find themselves in a jam, especially since the book names are not necessarily capitalized. Truthfully, from answers we get, we are forced to admit it usually takes a minister or a scholar to see some of them at the worst.
