Bible Trivia: (Answers to Last Week):

1. What is significant about the number 24? Twenty four Elders are found six times in the book of Revelation. Revelation 4:4 & 10, 5:8 & 14; 11:16; 19:4.
2. What is significant about the number 50? The day of Pentecost is the fiftieth day or Harvest feast to celebrate Passover. Also the day Peter preached and over 3,000 souls were saved. Acts 2.
3. What is significant about the number 12? The twelve Tribes of Israel, the twelve Apostles, and there were 12 baskets of food taken up, after Jesus feed 4,000 to 5,000 with two fish and 5 loaves. Mark 6:43, Luke 9:17, Matthew 14:20, Mark 8:19, John 6:13
4. What is significant about the number 70? Exodus 1:5, “And all the souls that came out of the loins of Jacob were seventy souls:”; We need to forgive our Brothers & Sisters 70 times 7, Matthew 18:22; and the Limited Commission sent out were 70: Luke 10:1: “After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come.” Luke 10:17: “And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.”
5. What is significant about the number 30? Our Savior was betrayed for thirty pieces of silver. Matthew 26 & 27. Such a small price for the King of Kings, and Lord of Lords... that died for my sins.

I jumped up one Sunday morning during service to give my testimony, and asked to join Fairview MBC. Brother Jerry Miller baptized me and about 4 others into the church that day.
