Bible Trivia: (Answers to Last Week):
 Martyrs in The Holy Bible

1. Who was the first martyr in the Bible, and how did he die?
Abel, killed by Cain Genesis 4
2. Who was the second martyr in the Bible, and how did he die?
Zechariah, Jesus tells us that Zechariah (the prophet) was killed between the temple and the altar (Matthew 23:35; Luke 11:51). We do know of a Zechariah from 2 Chronicles 24 who was stoned in the courtyard of the temple.
3. Who was the first recorded martyr in the New Testament, and how did he die? John the Baptist, He was killed by Herod the Tetrach in Matthew 14:1-12, by beheading.
4. Who was the second recorded martyr in the New Testament, and how did he die? Stephen, Acts 6 & 7 by stoning.
5. Who was the first of Jesus Twelve Disciples to suffer a martyrs death, and how did he die? James was killed by King Herod Agrippa I according to Acts 12:1, 2. He was killed by the sword during a time the king was starting to persecute the church.
