Martyrs in The Holy Bible

1. Was The Apostle Paul a martyr, if so how was he killed? Although not in the Scriptures, Nero condemned Paul to death by decapitation.
2. Was The Apostle Peter a martyr, if so how was he killed? According to Christian tradition, Peter was crucified in Rome under Emperor Nero Augustus Caesar. It is traditionally held that he was crucified upside down at his own request, since he saw himself unworthy to be crucified in the same way as Jesus.
3. Was The Apostle John a martyr, if so how was he killed? Christian tradition holds that he outlived the remaining apostles and that he was the only one to die of natural causes.
4. Was Jesus a martyr, if so how was he killed? Jesus said, "Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father." John 10:17 – 18. He died on the cross, but is alive forevermore! He arose from the grave, after three days and three nights. If He is classified as a martyr, He is the only one to raise from the dead by His own POWER!
