## *Pastor's Comments*

What a wonderful service the Lord gave us last Sunday! "Rejoice in the Lord ye righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness." **Psalms 97:12**. This, along with the letter sent last Thursday to all the members for which I have addresses, prompted me to share the following remarks.

Rejoice and give thanks – this is the essence of worship. We are to adore the Lord and show gratitude for what He has done for us. Jesus said to love Him with all our heart, soul mind and strength. This reflects the first commandment God gave Moses – thou shalt have no other gods before me.

The person we most love and respect in this life will recognize the attention and effort we put forth to please him or her. If we hold back expressing our feelings for people, they will not know or appreciate how we feel, because we do nothing to make our affections evident. If we tell them we have a great care for them but never show it by going out of our way for them, they may perceive we really don't care.

Of course God knows every individual that is saved, but how often do we show our appreciation of it? How often do we put Him first? When do we go out of our way to serve Him? What was the last thing you did for the Lord that made it necessary for you to miss out on something you would have really enjoyed? Is worshiping the Lord more important to you than anything else?

We rejoice in the pleasures of life but do we really rejoice for what the Lord did in dying for us to save our soul? Some folks settle for the idea, He knows I love Him so I don't have to outwardly show Him.

We know some people whom we believe loves us, but isn't it nice and reassuring for them to tell us once in a while or do something special for us. This helps strengthen our relationship and bonds of mutual affection. Do you think it works the same with God? He gave us a likeness unto Himself in our feelings and capability to reason. Isn't it reasonable to assume the Lord feels good when we acknowledge Him ?

Be thankful always for God's continued blessings and rejoice in His love and show that love in worshipping the Father and His Son regularly. Please read **Colossians 3:14-17**.
