# Pastor"s Comments

The Bible asks, "If God be for us, who can be against us?" On the contrary, if God is not for us, how can we stand?

Small countries, great nations and empires have come and gone. As Jesus indicated to Pilate, rulers and governments rise and fall at God's pleasure. It pleases God when leaders and nations follow His teachings. It's one thing to have never been for God and quite another to have walked with Him and then walked away.

America has been blessed by God as much as any nation while she has walked with God. In the past fifty years we, as a nation, have broken into a run away from God. Unless our country looks back and sees as we get father from Him the greater our difficulties multiply, we will become but another nation that comes to ruin.
