Last Supper Sermon



Bro. Armour began his message from 1 [Corinthians 11:2](#).

Now I praise you, brethren, that ye remember me in all things, and keep the ordinances, as I delivered them to you

The ordinances being baptism and the Lord's Supper. We must observe the first to be eligible for the second.

He read from Exodus 12 about the history of the Passover, comparing the lamb to Jesus. He then moved through the gospels that told of the first Lord's Supper.

He began with Luke 22 which relates this Passover and how it changed to a new covenant we now call the Lord's Supper.

He related the sequence of events that led to Judas's betrayal and his leaving the table before Jesus celebrated this ordinance with his disciples.

Bro. Armour then read from John 13, speaking about humility before the eating of the bread and the fruit of the vine.

1 Corinthians 11:27 speaks of taking this ordinance in error. A person must have their heart right before participating in this ordinance.

After further remarks, members of Faith, participated in this solemn service, going out after the singing of Amazing Grace.
