He loved the lord and he loved this old time way. The last year of his life he struggled with abdominal cancer and he went home to be with the Lord on July 25, 2003. One of the nurses at Alive Hospice said only days before he died, that he had never seen someone so at peace about dying.

What a testimony! God bless my Dads memory. He will live on in our hearts forever.
