Mayrene's sister had a stroke

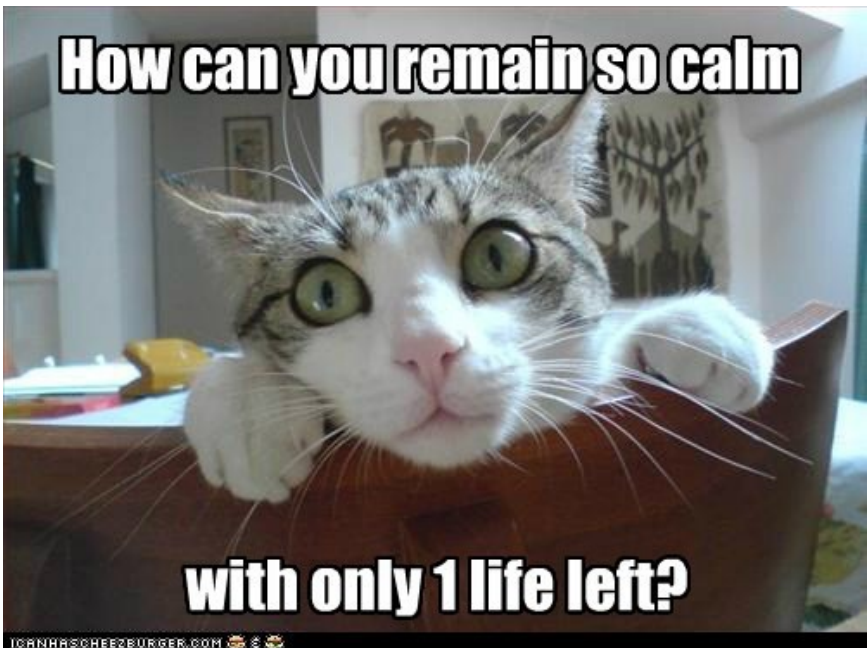
Don had his blood work done and it was all good. He will go for a CT next month to see the results of his treatments.
