Brother Coleman Taylor's sister, Virginia Gregory passed away this past week. Ms. Gregory was a member of Mt. Calvary.



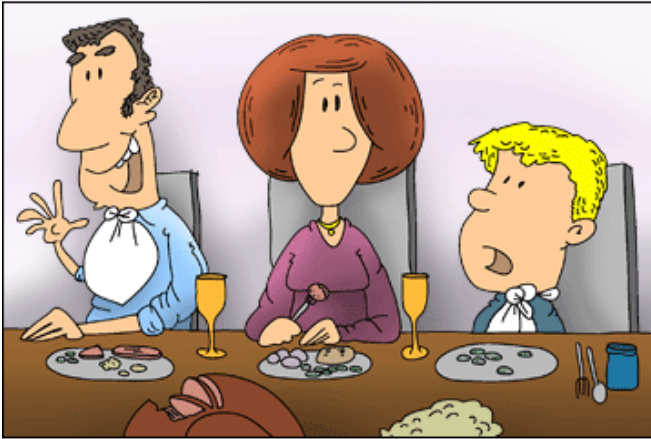


Laughter, the best medicine
