


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Update on Addyson: Addy had her first treatment Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of last week. It has been a rough week physically and emotionally. I walked in and out of the clinic several times last week. This has become our way of life to us but this week I happened to look up while walking through the door and saw the words cancer center in big letters above the door. Just seeing these two words...s made me wonder if all of this was real. These type of things only happen to people you read about. Some days this is all hard to digest. Especially when your child looks at you and says "worst day ever" because she feels pretty sick after getting chemo. She should be saying this because she lost a game in sports, or they were out of her favorite candy. Even in the midst of these challenging times God is still blessing us. He knew that we would have to walk this road and we are not having to do it alone. He is right there with us each step no matter how hard things get. There are others that are having it much worse than we are.

The first day of Addy's treatment was pretty rough. They had given her several meds to help with the nausea that made her pretty loopy. They decided to see if we could try to go home every night in between 7-8 hour days of being at the clinic to try and keep the new baby from having to come to the hospital and be exposed to sickness. It was very rough traveling back and forth like that especially with Addy not feeling very well. So from here on out we will do this inpatient where Addy can rest a whole lot more. Aspynn did excellent staying with my mom so that all worked out well. The doctor also put Addy on three days of steroids after treatment was finished. These are to help the chemo to work better and also to cut back on the nausea. The steroids made her in a pretty ill mood. Addy has been pretty tired taking several naps and feeling weak.

We took Addy to see the doctor today and to have her counts checked they were all ok for now. He says they usually begin to fall on the 10-14 day and we are on day 7 today. She is feeling a little more nauseated now that she is not taking the steroids and hasn't ate very much the past couple days but is still drinking well so we are glad for that. We will see the doctor and get counts checked again next Tuesday.

Thank you all so much for your prayers for Addy. I cannot begin to thank everyone enough for all the support, prayers, messages and so many other things that are being done for us. We are so blessed to have such great people to help us while on this journey. Love and blessings, The Clark Family.
